Citizens of the United States generally feel some responsibility for the democratic society supported by them. Having voted for government officials, they share the responsibility for the acts of the officials. While all citizens of a democratic society can take pride in national achievements, they are also morally involved in the wrong actions of their public officials.

Americans are often *¹accused of a lack of respect for their government officials. This isn't fair. Americans realize that public officials are human and that as human beings these officials make errors in judgement. When presidents or mayors act wisely and sensibly, Americans approve and elect them again. On the other hand, when public officials act unwisely or carelessly, Americans feel a responsibility to *²protest. Their protest may be expressed through an organization, through a labor group, or through the *³constitution that allows citizens to force useless public officials to leave their positions. Many people do not understand that protest is a great responsibility in a democracy. Only through protest can a society be kept free and open.

In short, if the individual accepts the values of democracy, he or she must accept the responsibilities of democracy. The responsibilities in a free society are heavy for all citizens.
