The desert in Australia is called “the Outback.” The name comes from the words “out in the back of the mountains and cities.” The weather there is very hot and dry, and the winds are strong. Sometimes there is no rain for many years. When it rains, it causes floods!

Most of the people in the Outback have cattle or sheep farms. The farms are called stations. The stations are very big and some of them are as big as a small country. So, living in the Outback is different because distances are very far. People get mail only once a week. They still go shopping in town once a week or even once a month. They also need to buy a lot of food and supplies, which are kept in their houses. Children don't go to school every day because sometimes it takes a day or two to drive to school. Instead, they study through a school called “the School of the Air.” The teacher and student talk to each other with a special radio. When people become sick, they call “the Royal Flying Doctor Service” and follow the doctor's advice over the radio. In an \*emergency, an airplane is used to take the sick person to the nearest hospital.

Living in the Outback is very difficult, but it is good, too. There they are close to nature, and there are many unusual animals. They also have a lot of freedom.
