There are about 200 nations in the world. They can be divided into two groups, "developed" and "developing," according to their level of economic development. About 150 of these nations are developing countries and most of the world's population lives in these countries. Although every developing country has its own particular circumstances, most suffer from similar problems. One of the major problems is hunger.

Food is a basic need. Those who are fortunate can eat three meals a day. However, over 840 million people around the world go hungry every day. In addition, more than 500 million people can not get enough \*nutrition from the food they eat to stay healthy. Hunger also kills; 34,000 children under age five die from hunger and related causes daily. Why are so many people going hungry?

One of the main causes of hunger is poverty. Most of the people who are hungry do not have enough money to purchase the food they need. The poorest people live in Africa, while the largest number of people who continually suffer from poor nutrition live in the Asia-Pacific area. However, hunger remains especially severe in South Asia, where growing poverty, debt, a \*\*worsening economic situation, bad weather, and war have all caused this area's food problems. Even in the United States, which is regarded as a developed country, the share of the population facing hunger has risen. Still, compared with developing countries, hunger in wealthy nations is neither severe nor widely spread.

We should think more about the importance of food and try not to waste it. Also, as global citizens, we should work hard to solve this problem.
