Two different kinds of animals are called pandas. The giant panda belongs to the bear family. The lesser panda looks like a \*<sup>1</sup>raccoon, and is in a separate family of its own.

Giant pandas are one of the most popular animals in the world, and also one of the rarest. Though most people have seen them in photographs or on TV, few have seen one in the wild. They are kept in a few zoos, but rarely \*<sup>2</sup>breed in captivity.

Giant pandas live only in the high mountains in China. Groups of these pandas may be seen in the \*<sup>3</sup>breeding season, but at other times they live alone.

Giant pandas take up to 12 hours a day eating their main diet of tough \*<sup>4</sup>bamboo. They have a special bone in their hands which they use like we use our thumbs, so they are able to hold their food. Although they do eat other plants, and sometimes catch small animals and birds, many pandas die of hunger if the bamboo crop fails.

Actually, the number of giant pandas is very small, but this has little to do with people. It is mainly because of changes in climate and plants since the end of the last ice age. Even though giant pandas are an \*<sup>5</sup>endangered species, people try their best to protect them, so these animals may live longer than many of the world's other rare animals.

Carla, a 23-year-old shop assistant, is one of Naomi's \*4clients. "Naomi told me so many things about myself that she couldn't have ( b )," says Carla. "She knew I was going to be married. She also said I didn't like my job, and she was right both times!"

Carla is not alone. Thousands of people visit psychics, and Americans spend 300 million dollars a year on telephone calls to psychic hot lines. As many as half of all Americans believe in ESP.

( c ), many people are doubtful about the idea of ESP. They think it does not exist. They say that, first of all, psychics just make good guesses. They use \*5clues, such as a client's age and appearance, to guess things about their lives. Some guesses turn out to be correct, while others do not. Afterwards, clients often only remember the ( a ) guesses. They forget the times when the psychic was wrong. Secondly, psychics often make a lot of very ( e ) statements. These statements are true for many people, so they have a good chance of being right.
