In many ways, traveling is much easier and faster than it was in the past. However, traveling fast doesn't always mean traveling in comfort. These days, a large number of people travel by air, but long plane flights are unpleasant for many of them. Flying can even be dangerous for some of them. Why? This is because passengers in planes have to sit still.

In fact, doctors say that sitting still for a long time is not good for you. When you sit still for many hours, your blood doesn't flow well, especially in your legs. When the blood stops flowing well, you may get a blood *clot in your leg. This can be painful. It can also have more serious effects on your health. If the blood clot breaks up, the small clots can then travel to other parts of the body. If they get into the lungs, the heart, or the brain, there is a risk of death.

Fortunately, there are simple ways to prevent that. First, before you go on a long flight, you should talk to your doctor. If you have a high risk of blood clots, you should wear special stockings on your legs. Second, you should try to keep your blood flowing well during a long flight. You can get up now and then and walk down the **aisle. You can also do exercises at your seat. Many airline companies now show videos that explain how to do these exercises. They are just simple movements of the arms, legs, and head, but they help the blood flow better. If you do these things, you will be able to enjoy a long flight and travel comfortably.
