Lopez Lomong ran and ran with his friends for three days until they reached *¹Kenya from his home country, *²South Sudan. He had to run from the enemy camp where he was going to be killed. Fortunately, he was able to get to a *³refugee camp in Kenya and finally move to the U.S. in 2001.

His family thought Lomong had been killed and he thought his family were all dead. But they met again in 2003. In high school, he joined the *⁴track and field team. He won almost all the races. He officially became an American citizen in 2007 and became an Olympic *⁵athlete for the U.S. Olympic team for 2008. He was chosen as the U.S. *⁶flag bearer at the *⁷Beijing Olympic opening. Although he couldn't win any medals, he didn't give up running.

Before the London Olympics, he took part in a 5,000 meter race in the U.S. He thought he finished the race first, but the people in the stadium shouted, "Keep running!" Then he realized that he had to run another 400 meters to finish the race. How lucky and strong he was to be able to enter the London Olympics!

From his life, we can learn a lot of things and we can say that no one knows what will happen next. Lomong is still running for the U.S., for South Sudan and for world peace.
