*¹Hayabusa left the earth on May 9, 2003 and returned on June 13, 2010. It landed on an *²asteroid named Itokawa after a very long journey and brought back samples of sand and other surface materials.

During its long journey, it faced many troubles. These happened one after another. Landing on Itokawa was difficult and gathering the samples was even more difficult. Communication was lost for a long time and then two engines broke down, but the engineers on Earth overcame the problems. When Hayabusa finally finished its 6 million-kilometer journey, seven years had passed.

The samples Hayabusa brought back from Itokawa will help us understand a lot of things about space. Hayabusa's successful adventure also gave us something more important. As Mr. Junichiro Kawaguchi, who led the project team said, "Hayabusa taught us that a strong will and patience are very important in life." The return of Hayabusa gave power to people all over the world. No wonder so many people made long lines and waited for hours to see Hayabusa's *³capsule at museums around Japan.

Hayabusa *⁴released this capsule which contained its collected samples, and then burned up when it entered the earth's *⁵atmosphere. However, the memory of Hayabusa will live in our hearts forever.
