



*Habit for Humanity* is one of these groups. They build homes for the poor. Their most famous volunteer is former U.S. president Jimmy Carter, who won the Nobel Prize for Peace. *Habit for Humanity* volunteers do not need special \*<sup>1</sup>skills. They just need to be in good health. Volunteers build homes in the United States, but they also build homes all over the world. Many volunteers pay for their own trips.

Another group is called *Earthwatch*. They get volunteers to help scientists in many places around the world. For example, the volunteers may help with studies of \*<sup>2</sup>endangered animals. Most of the trips last for two weeks. Volunteers pay about \$1,800 to take part. They usually stay in \*<sup>3</sup>dormitories and cook their meals together.
